In 2021, Sarah graduated with a bachelor's degree in Dairy Science from Virginia Tech. Just two years later, in 2023, she graduated with her master's degree in Agricultural Communication, Education, and Leadership from The Ohio State University where her research focused on assessing communication needs with Spanish speakers on dairy farms.

Currently, Sarah resides in Ohio and serves as a Product Support Analyst at Select Sires Inc. providing support for Select Mating Service, the company's mating program. She is also an assistant coach under Bonnie Ayars for The Ohio State University's dairy judging team, serves as an advisor to the Ohio Junior Holstein Association, and finds herself back in the showring whenever she can.
