He was president of the Illinois Jersey Cattle club, served as president of the Illinois PDCA. He has served on the All-American panel for Ayrshire, Guernsey, Milking Shorthorn, and Jersey breeds. He represents US Jersey on the World dairy expo exhibitor committee and is a Director for the AJCA. He was the recipient of the 2021 Max Gordon award. Over the past 30 years, he has judged various breeds at over 30 State Fairs. Ted has judged the All American Jersey show three times, the All American Jersey Jug twice, All American Junior show once as well as many other National shows for Jerseys and other breeds.
